

RESOLUTION OF THE ALAMEDA CONNECTS

BOARD OF DIRECTORS

Regular Meeting of June 11, 2019

Whereas, at the regular meeting of the Alameda Gateway Community Association Board of Directors on September 12, 2017 the board adopted a resolution in opposition to the proposed Lakewood 1% Growth Limitation measure on the City of Lakewood regular election ballot for November, 2017.

Whereas, the Alameda Gateway Community Association subsequently changed its legal name to Alameda Connects.

Whereas, the 1% Growth Limitation measure (Question 200) is now on the ballot for a City of Lakewood Special Election scheduled for July 2, 2019.

Whereas, the Alameda Connects Board of Directors hereby reaffirms its previous resolution as follows:

The Alameda Connects Board of Directors has reviewed the 1% Growth Limitation measure known as Question 200 that will be on the City of Lakewood July 2019 Special Election ballot and has concluded that it is not in the best interests of the businesses on the Alameda Corridor or the Lakewood community as a whole.

This measure adds additional unwarranted bureaucracy on top of existing comprehensive land use plans and zoning and permitting regulations and is an unneeded impediment to positive investment.

This measure is inconsistent with and unfavorable to the goals of economic development, promotion, enhancement and beautification of the Alameda Corridor.
